So warm and so tight. *(hug self)*

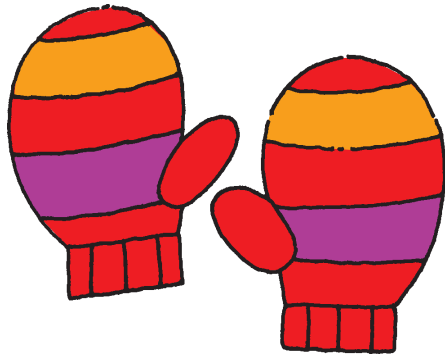
I wiggle my pinkies, *(wiggle pinkies on both hands)*

Big Hill

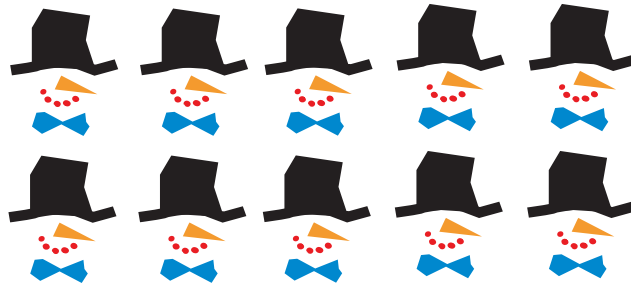
Here's a big hill
